NOTE

We would like to inform you that the generator of applications for granting a social scholarship in the winter semester of the academic year. 2025/2026 was launched on October 2 and will be open until October 14 this year. Paper applications must be submitted by October 14.

In the case of all foreigners applying for a social scholarship, all documents are required the same as in the case of Polish citizens, including certificates from the tax office or the institution corresponding to the tax office, e.g. the State Fiscal Service, regarding the amount of income taxed under general principles, including income from activities. If a family member has not submitted a tax return, you must provide proof that the family member cannot obtain the appropriate certificate from the tax office.

If the certificate from the tax office shows that a foreign student is unable to obtain an appropriate income certificate, income certificates from employers must be provided.

Procedures based on income certificates from employers must be preceded by the foreign student demonstrating (based on a certificate from the office or another institution corresponding to the tax office) that it is not possible for the foreign student to provide the appropriate income certificate. Additionally, after presenting income from employers, you must provide statements that family members do not earn any other income than the one shown.

If a foreign student or a family member stayed on the territory of Poland in the tax year preceding the academic year, income certificates from the Polish Tax Office must also be provided.
